

Seeping of respiratory secretions through the meshed netting and the ability to raise the mattress improve their clearance from the upper respiratory tract

The ability to raise the AirNettress head is an added benefit in the treatment of upper respiratory tract infections and acute bronchitis which are the most common respiratory illnesses during infancy and childhood. This position improves clearance of secretions from the upper airway.

Seeping of rhinorrhea, mucus and regurgitated food through AirNettress porous mesh prevents the possibility of rebreathing and aspiration.
