

**Assessment of AirNettress

As per your request, I have examined two AirNettress mattresses, manufactured by Lizron, Child Development Company. One of the two mattresses was in use by a child for a year prior to my examination. Both mattresses are made from a special net stretched over a wooden frame and had good resilience which is sufficient for good support of a baby or a child.

The mattress will not cause any skeletal deformity in the baby using it. In my opinion, the use of the stretched net, which has no focal depressions, may encourage infant and child development in the early years of life. This assumption necessitates further research to confirm it.

In conclusion, from an orthopedic view point, the AirNettress mattress, manufactured by Lizron, Child Development Company is as good as any other baby or child mattress and may encourage infant development without causing skeletal deformities.
