

## **The porous surface of Nettress provides for urine permeation and creation of a dry surface devoid of urine**

Two significant factors in urine induced dermatitis are wetness which leads to excessive hydration and skin maceration with loss of barrier function and skin irritation by contact with urine.

**The porous netting of Nettress facilitates urine permeation and allows for constant aeration thus, creating a dry surface, devoid of urine on which the baby/toddler sleeps.** The dry environment and lack of contact with urine significantly reduce the risk factors for skin irritation and dermatitis.
